She graduated from the High School of Performing Arts in New York City. Her first leading role was in Home Sweetie Home as Gertrude at age fifteen. In 1986, she appeared on the cover of Jet magazine. She appeared as Czerniawska in The Young Indiana Jones Chronicles in the episode "Journey to Jerusalem" and as Mary Magdalene in the Doctor Who episode "The Girl Who Waited". She played the role of Jodie Foster's mother in the family film Moon Over Parador, which opened on August 29, 1996. She was the co-writer and producer of the short film American Dreams, an indie film that explored issues of freedom of speech and racial discrimination in the United States. The film was a finalist for the Sundance Film Festival in the 1992 US dramatic short films category. The film also received a "Best of Show" Award from the Ann Arbor Film Festival. It premiered at the Newport International Film Festival on August 30, 1995 and had a limited theatrical run in the United States. In 2004, Longo was the executive producer and co-writer of a science fiction film called A Trip to Rymkwyh, which was completed and marketed.
